

What are the Man of Earth Delegates?

Liber 194: An Intimation with Reference to the Constitution of the Order states,

“In order that the feelings of the general body may be represented, the Men of Earth choose four persons, two men and two women, from among themselves, to stand continually before the face of the Supreme and Holy King, serving him day and night.”

The Man of Earth Delegates serve two functions: representing the needs, sentiments, concerns, and ideas of the Man of Earth Triad (Minerval through P.I.) to the Supreme and Holy King, as well as serving as a direct channel to the King for any member of the Man of Earth.

Though “[t]he Man of Earth takes no share in the Government of the Order,” the Man of Earth Triad does have representation to the King in the form of Delegates.

Man of Earth Delegates are similar to members of U.S. Congress, since they represent the constituents of the Man of Earth Triad to the King. The Nomination Panel functions as a proto-electoral college to evaluate and nominate volunteer candidates for appointment as Man of Earth Delegates.

Why would I talk to a Delegate?

Delegates advocate for and serve in the interest of the Order's largest group of initiates: the Man of Earth Triad.

Any Man of Earth initiate may contact the Delegates, either collectively or individually, if they feel they have matters which should come to the attention of the Supreme and Holy King.

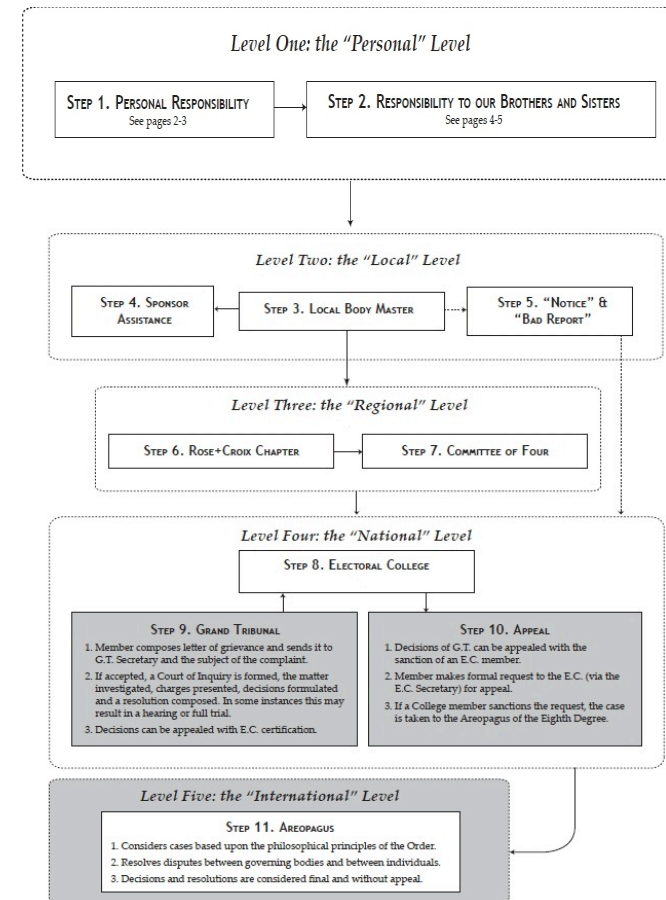
Although it is important that initiates follow the Path of Mediation, this may not always be appropriate. One example of a reportable issue could be a concern with a policy or custom at an initiate's local body. In these cases, the Delegate(s) can present the issue to the Supreme and Holy King. All concerns will be given due consideration.

Additionally, Man of Earth initiates are encouraged to provide their unique perspectives regarding their experience in the Order to foster a supportive atmosphere for all initiates.

What is the Path of Mediation?

The Path of Mediation is a dispute resolution tool utilized within the Order.

The chart below illustrates the process that members of the Order can follow to resolve issues between fellow Brethren.

How do I become a Delegate?

"These persons must not be of higher rank than the Second Degree; they must volunteer for this service at the conclusion of that ceremony; and therefore they give up their own prospect of advancement in the Order for one year, that they may serve their fellows."

If you are II° and have not yet submitted an application for III°, we encourage you to apply. You will need two letters of reference from initiates that are of at least I° who are not members of the Nominating Panel. Appointments occur every January and July, with the applications due on December 1st and June 1st.
